My dear - Raja Bhai,

Permit me to address you
with this personal letter, though I know you are the
busiest member of the Presidential cabinet.
I do it with the re-assuring knowledge
that you have some consideration for me and mine
as I do also have a consistently high estimate
about your distinguished self.
You know C.T.'s course is under a
process of expansion and development at an estimated
cost of Rs 47. lacs under the 2nd Five Year Plan.
In the process of expansion and
development, as first basic requirement we
had to acquire lands for the construction of
the new buildings of the College. Thus, quite
understandably, the college administration for
no personal fault of their own, had to incur
its deep displeasure of affected parties. The whole
acquisition work had to be executed only
for the improvement and development of the College which,
though founded in 1869, was sadly neglected in
the past.

During the middle of September, I found some substantial encroachment on Govt land at the northern side of the Principal's Bungalow area and I had to report the matter to the C & B Deptt. become an eye-sore to a section of professional students and the whole lot of disgruntled ^{and discredited} politicians here.

Perhaps I have already snatched away much of your precious time. As my relation I have claims on your attentive sympathy and as the supreme captain of the Ship of Education in Pakistan I need your just protection. Please take whatever immediate action you deem suitable.

The other day I was reading with fascinated delight your extremely forceful and thought-provoking address delivered at the Lahore Administrative Staff College.

It touches the deepest chord in a true Pakistani heart. May Allah lead you from strength to strength in the blink of an eye. Trust this finds you in the blink.
